

# Wearable Muslin

Have you been quilting for a while, you know your way around your sewing machine, but you aren't quite ready to tackle garment construction on your own? Or maybe you've tried to make a garment, but you are unsure about sizing and fit. This class will walk you through the process of a reading a pattern and making a garment that fits.

We will be working with the 1025 Laurel pattern by Colette to make a wearable muslin (aka mock-up pattern) of a basic sheath dress. After this class you will be able to make a whole closet full of dresses/tops based on this pattern.
